

Crimestopper's Tip Leads to the Arrest of Attempted Armed Robbery Suspect

New Orleans, LA – Members of the New Orleans Police Department have arrested 23 year old Donald Myles and booked him in connection with the attempted armed robbery that occurred on November 24, 2008, at approximately 8:45 P.M., in the 400 block of Philip Street.

According to investigators, the victim was approached by an unknown suspect who produced a handgun and demanded his money. The victim refused to comply and advised the suspect that there were several surveillance cameras in the area. The suspect then fled the scene and was last scene heading towards Rousseau Street then unknown.

As a result of a crimestopper's tip, Detective Matthew McCleary positively identified Donald Myles as the person responsible for the attempted armed robbery. The suspect was apprehended by a Sixth District Task Force unit in the 2800 block of Chippewa Street, at approximately 6:30 P.M.
