## **Suspect Arrested Shortly After Committing A Murder**

New Orleans, LA - Members of the New Orleans Police Department have arrested 30-year-old Andre Hankton and booked him with Second Degree Murder and has issued an arrest warrant for 31-year-old Telly T. Hankton for murder, wanted in connection with the apparent shooting death of an unidentified male. The offense occurred May 13, 2008 at approximately 9:30 P.M., in the 3400 block of South Claiborne Avenue.

According to investigators, Second District officers received a call of a "male shot" and upon their arrival found the victim lying on the sidewalk with multiple gunshot wounds to the body. Emergency Medical Personnel arrived on the scene and pronounced the victim dead.

A short while later, police located the vehicle and place the driver into custody.

Detectives learned the victim was chased while driving his vehicle by the two suspects driving another vehicle. The victim exited his vehicle at some point and attempted to flee on foot. He was chased then struck by the suspect's vehicle then shot. The driver of the suspect vehicle fled in the vehicle and the other suspect fled on foot.
