Crimestopper's Tip Leads To The Arrest Of A Murder Suspect

New Orleans, LA – The New Orleans Police Department announced the arrest of 40-year-old Timothy Washington wanted in connection with a murder that occurred on May 23, 2008 in the 700 block of Thayer Street.

According to investigators, the suspect shot the victim where he later died at the hospital.

As a result of the follow up investigation, detectives identified Timothy Washington as the person responsible for the Murder and issued an arrest warrant.

The New Orleans Police Department's Violent Offenders Warrant Squad and the United States Marshals Fugitive Task Force tracked Washington through a Crimestopper's Tip to a house in the 2200 block of Church Street in Vacherie La., where he was arrested by the Marshals this morning. Washington will be transported to New Orleans and booked with Murder.
