

Crimestopper's Tip Leads to The Identity Of The Suspect Wanted For Obscenity

New Orleans, LA - Members of The New Orleans Police Department are requesting the public's assistance in locating 55-year-old Robert Malinda (alias Bob Louis) as the suspect wanted for exposing himself. The incident occurred Saturday February 6, 2010 in the late afternoon near the old clubhouse in Audubon Park.

According to investigators, the suspect approached two minor female victims, exposed himself and then fled on foot. The victims alerted their father that was with them. The victim's father approached the suspect and managed to take several photos of the suspect.

During the course of the investigation, a Crimestopper's tip was received that led to the identity of Robert Malinda. Detective Patrick Conaghan positively identified Robert Malinda as the person responsible for the incident and secured an arrest warrant for one count of Obscenity.
