Crimestopper's Tip Lead to the Identity of Two Robbery Suspects

New Orleans, LA –As a result of a recent Crimestopper's tip, the New Orleans Police Department's Sixth District Investigative Unit has identified 19-year-old Shaquille Cooper and 20-year-old Gregg Kagler, as the persons responsible with the armed robbery that occurred on February 16, 2011, at a local bar in the 900 block of

Saint Mary Street

According to investigators, two African-American males approached the victim, brandished a weapon and demanded the victim's cell phone. As a result of the victim refusing to relinquish his cell phone, the suspects' struck the victim several times and subsequently shot him.

Throughout the course of the investigation, an anonymous caller contacted CrimeStopper's with information on the identity of the suspects. That information was then forwarded to Detective Krzemieniecki who positively identified Cooper and Kagler as the persons responsible for the robbery.

You do not have to give your name nor testify to receive the reward.
