

Louisiana Revised Statute 32:407 - Driver's License Guidelines

Age	Eligible For	Pre-Licensing Requirement	Restrictions
15 y.o.	Learner's License	Successful completion of driver's ed course* Pass visual exam Pass written test with OMV	Must be accompanied by a licensed parent, guardian, adult at least age twenty-one or older, or licensed sibling at least age eighteen or older
16 y.o.	Intermediate License	Possess learner's license for 180 days 50 hours driving practice with parent 15 of those hours must be night time driving No at-fault crashes (with Learner's License) No moving violations (with Learner's License) No drug or alcohol law violations Pass on-road driving test	Restricted from driving between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. unless otherwise accompanied by a licensed parent or guardian, a licensed adult at least twenty-one years of age, or a licensed sibling at least eighteen years of age. May not, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., transport more than one passenger that is under twenty-one years of age and not a member of the intermediate licensee's immediate family
17 y.o.	Class "E" License	Complete requirements for Intermediate License No at-fault crashes (12 consecutive months) No moving violations (12 consecutive months) No drug or alcohol law violations (12 consecutive months)	No restrictions

* - students under age 15 may not take driver's education unless they are in 9th grade and within 90 days of their 15th birthday
